## §29: THE JOURNEY INTO GALILEE

**Matt. 4:12; Mark 1:14a; Luke 4:14a; John 4:1–3**

<p><b>12</b> Now having heard that John had been handed over, He withdrew into Galilee.</p>	<p><b>14a</b> Now after John had been handed over, Jesus came into Galilee.</p>	<p><b>14a</b> And Jesus returned into Galilee in the power of the Spirit.</p>	<p><b>1</b> When therefore Jesus knew that the Pharisees heard that Jesus was making and baptizing more disciples than John—</p> <p><b>2</b> and yet Jesus Himself was not baptizing, but His disciples—</p> <p><b>3</b> He left Judea and departed again into Galilee.</p>

### Notes

1. John was arrested by Herod for the reason stated later in Matt. 14:3–4. We will discuss this in more detail when we get to Matt. 14 and parallels.
2. On John 4:3 “He left Judea and departed *again* into Galilee,” note that Jesus went to Galilee after His baptism earlier in John 2:1ff., then went to Jerusalem in John 2:13, and is now going back “again” to Galilee.
