Notes

1. The same reaction of the people to Jesus' teaching is recorded at the end of the Sermon on the Mount, Matt. 7:28–29, almost word for word with Mark 1:22: "The crowds were amazed at his teaching, for he was teaching them as one having authority, and not as their scribes."
